iii	It was in this context, Government of India took a number of steps including
1	Seeds Legislation. In 1966 the Seeds Act was enacted by the Parliament. Rules
10	under this Act were issued, later on seed was declared an Essential Commodity under the Essential Commodities Act. Seeds (Control) Order was issued on
25	December, 1983.
28	It is necessary that all the above information is available at one place, so that
29	those who are connected with production, distribution, seed law enforcements etc. can get all the guidance at one place. I hope that this booklet will meet the longfelt
30	requirements of the seed sector and will be useful to all concerned.
